

1 hundreds of thousands of dollars. So, it
2 just --

3 Q Okay. All right. During his deposition,
4 Gary Lantrip testified, "When Eddie said
5 he was going to drop her, he said he's
6 f'd" --

7 MS. ISAAK: I am sorry. Let me
8 start over.

9 Q (As read) "When Eddie said he was going
10 to drop her, he said she has f-ed
11 everybody in Gadsden, including himself.
12 And that her dad was a doctor, and they
13 used to throw sex parties when she was
14 young, so she was put in with that as a
15 young girl. And he has known her her
16 whole life."

17 A I don't know if that is exactly what I
18 said. I probably did. I mean, I
19 probably did tell him that I had sex with
20 her.

21 MS. EAGAN: And just for
22 clarification, this is the
23 meeting with Breitbart, that he

1 was saying that -- that you
2 said that.

3 A Oh, no. Yeah, no, I am sorry. No.

4 Q No, this was not the meeting with
5 Breitbart. This was the meeting -- the
6 morning meeting --

7 MS. EAGAN: Okay.

8 Q -- prior to the meeting with Breitbart.

9 A Yeah, I don't know -- I don't know that I
10 would have said all that because I -- I
11 just don't think I did, but I may -- I
12 may have -- I am pretty sure I probably
13 did tell him about my relationship with
14 Leigh, though.

15 Q Okay.

16 A I am pretty positive about that because I
17 was trying to tell him anything that
18 would dissuade him from asking me to do
19 anything else.

20 And really and truly, when I
21 sent him the -- the text and junk and
22 whatever I sent him that day that I took
23 screen shots of that he has, I absolutely

1 thought that this would disappear and
2 nobody would ever bring it up again,
3 ever.

4 Q All right. Now, the comment "she has
5 f-ed everybody in Gadsden" --

6 A I don't know if I said exactly that. I
7 mean, I think -- I don't know that it is
8 any great big secret that she had had
9 sexual relations with more than one
10 person. I don't -- I mean, I don't --
11 and I don't think -- I mean, I just don't
12 see -- I don't see any reason to deny it.
13 I actually think that it is symptomatic
14 of what happened to her. But I am not a
15 psychologist, so I can't make a medical
16 opinion.

17 Q Are you saying that maybe she was
18 promiscuous because of what she alleges
19 happened to her?

20 A I am saying -- no. What I am saying is
21 is that that could be an -- I have -- I
22 have said that publicly before -- before
23 Gary and them ever talked to me.

1 Q You said that she had sex with multiple
2 people in Gadsden?

3 A That I think -- no, that I think that
4 that is a symptom or indication that
5 something happened.

6 Q That what is a symptom or indication that
7 something happened?

8 A Being promiscuous or -- or reckless with
9 anything I think is.

10 Q Okay. And would you describe her as
11 promiscuous or reckless during that time?

12 MS. EAGAN: Object to the form.

13 A Yeah.

14 MS. EAGAN: During what time?

15 A I mean --

16 MS. EAGAN: Hold on a second.

17 During what time?

18 Q Well, let's say her teenage years.

19 A No more than -- or for no other reason
20 other than what people say the same thing
21 that I would hear about Roy Moore and his
22 propensity for younger girls. I mean --
23 I mean, no. Do I know that for a fact?

1 No. Don't. Never seen her with anybody
2 else. I don't know. But I had heard, I
3 mean, teenagers, boys, talk about all
4 kinds of stuff.

5 So, would I say more than one,
6 more than five, more than 100? I have no
7 clue. You know, I just don't. So, I
8 guess --

9 Q Okay. So, you -- you threw in there
10 Judge Moore's name. What do you mean by
11 that? You said no more than --

12 A Because I had heard -- I had heard stuff
13 about him, too, but I am not -- I am not
14 going to say Judge Moore is this or that
15 because I don't know.

16 Q Okay.

17 A And I don't know about Leigh about -- as
18 far as that goes. She never told me:
19 Oh, I had sex with John in the bathroom
20 somewhere.

21 Q Just things that you have heard; is that
22 what you are basing your statement on?

23 A Yeah, I guess general. Yeah. I mean, if

1 anything, that is what it would be. And
2 I have never heard, like, some specific
3 number or, you know, anything crazy.

4 Q Yeah, I am not asking that.

5 A I know.

6 Q I am just asking for, you know, the basis
7 behind the statement "she has f-ed
8 everybody in Gadsden."

9 MS. EAGAN: Object to the form.

10 A I don't know if I made that statement,
11 but --

12 Q Okay.

13 A I mean, I don't know, really.

14 Q Okay. And what about the following
15 statement, "Her Dad was a doctor, and
16 they used to throw sex parties when she
17 was young, so she was put into that as a
18 young girl."

19 A I don't know -- I don't know about young.
20 I said that I had heard that, too. I
21 mean, I probably did tell him that. And
22 I don't know if it was her -- I don't
23 know if her -- I guess her dad, step-dad,

1 something, her mother. I mean, I had
2 always heard stuff like that, but who
3 knows if it was true or not. I never
4 saw. I never witnessed it.

5 Q Okay.

6 A I don't know anybody else that had
7 personal knowledge of it that ever told
8 me that. So...

9 Q Well, who had you heard that from, then?

10 A I don't know. Probably people at the
11 Country Club, kinda-sorta. Like, it
12 would have been kids. I don't know
13 nothing. I doubt it would have been
14 somebody that would have claimed to be
15 there.

16 Just her mom is pretty, and I
17 think she was divorced. And I don't know
18 if, in Gadsden, that is -- it leads to a
19 lot of speculation about everything.
20 It's kind of a weird little town.

21 Q Okay. Do you think any of those
22 comments, as testified by Gary Lantrip,
23 are disparaging of Leigh Corfman?

1 A I think they could be, yeah.

2 Q Okay. Do you think anything that you
3 said in relation to Leigh Corfman was
4 disparaging or could be interpreted as
5 disparaging?

6 A Not really. Not that I can think of.

7 Q Okay.

8 A I mean. I mean, actually, I was, if
9 anything, overboard supportive of her.
10 Because I thought, at least by doing
11 that, that they would see how insane it
12 was to even ask me to say something like
13 that.

14 MS. ISAAK: All right. It is 12:50.
